

**MINUTES OF MEETING  
NOOSA EUMUNDI DISTRICT DRESSAGE**

**Date:** 1<sup>st</sup> July 2009, 7.30 p.m.

1. Previous minutes were read by Julie Watson and confirmed by Tanya Armstrong.
2. The previous Mrs. Tanya Kalnoky is now Tanya Armstrong and future correspondence is to be addressed as such!
3. Julie Watson was updated on the reasoning for limiting the rides to 100 and agreed it was a good idea. Julie was also updated on the increased fees for Associate classes for those competitors who do not volunteer some form of assistance.
4. Current nominations were discussed and at this stage it appears there will only be 60 to 70 rides, therefore the Committee members felt it was an opportunity to nominate as well, as the work load would be less than previous competitions.
5. Prize money will reflect the number of riders in a class i.e. \$30, \$25, \$20, if less than four riders in a class.
6. Horse and Rider Saddlery would be asked to sponsor the Associate Classes again. Kay Thornton to action.
7. David Leando will purchase 20 boxes of Roses chocolates for writers and Tanya Armstrong will purchase wine for judges.
8. The trophy on lay-by at Horselands was discussed and its possible presentation at the September Championships to the highest percentage score on the day.
9. The “voluntary” payment of membership by committee members needs to be added to the Constitution.
10. Minutes of the Meeting need to be on the website and advertising of the next meeting needs to also appear on the website so members are able to attend if they wish.

11. Treasurer, Tanya Armstrong, reported all accounts are currently paid
12. David Leando was able to purchase a printer for NEDD for \$25.00. Payment was passed by Treasurer Tanya Armstrong.
13. Margaret McCormack reported ribbons have been ordered and will be ready prior to the Championships in September.
14. Due to the low numbers for the next competition, it was decided that probably two arenas would be ample. A starting time of 9.00 a.m. was suggested with the day finished around 2.00 p.m.
