

**MINUTES OF MEETING

1. Previous minutes were read by Julie Watson and confirmed by Tanya Armstrong.
2. Ltd Edition Show Time Trophy Shown to Committee and views are to get a new plaque for trophy. The winner of such will be the highest percentage on the day. Trophy to be advertised on Sept Program
3. Committee not to pay membership – On reflection it was deemed better for the committee members to pay their memberships and all were in agreement that all working members would receive free entry at comps for themselves only
4. Monies Owing – David paid owed \$20.00 from Petty Cash. Website Design and extra update by Michael Howard Paid \$715.00. Tasch has asked to receive a payment for fuel for the pick up and drop off of Arenas in July & Aug. NAGS Arena Hire to be paid \$150.00.
5. Prize Money, Ribbons and Presentations – It was agreed that Classes before lunch would be able to pick up prizes and ribbons through out the day (winners should present to gear check) for those whom need to leave and to avoid Tanya having to post out prizes etc. A presentation would be held for the afternoon classes to ensure some help with the pack down of arenas.
